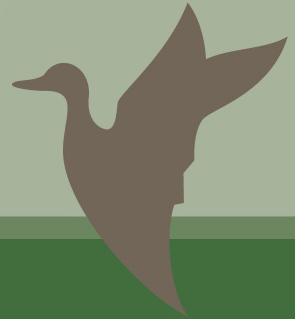




Gauche Aquatic Park Verkada Camera System Upgrade

Background

- The current camera system at Gauche Aquatic Park was installed in 2017 and is reaching its end of useful life.
- Since this system was installed, camera technology has greatly improved.
- The City has seen an increase in vandalism and would like to continue its efforts at identifying those responsible while protecting City facilities.
- The camera upgrade was proposed and approved as a capital acquisition item in the City's operating budget for the FY 21/22.
- The City currently uses the Verkada camera system at the Police Department, Wastewater Treatment Facility and SASA.



FB 22-06

- A formal request for proposals was developed and advertised according to the City's ordinances. FB22-06 was posted on November 4, 2021 and closed on November 30, 2021.
- A mandatory walk-through was held and three vendors participated in the walk-through for the proposal.
- Three proposals were received for FB22-06.
- A committee made up of IT staff evaluated the proposals using the following criteria: Cost, Compliance with FB, Capability, Experience, Qualifications and References.

- Based on staff evaluations, Gaynor Telesystems proposal included all items specified by the City and is determined to be the most responsive bidder.



Recommendation

- A. Adopt a Resolution awarding the contract for the Gauche Aquatic Park Verkada Camera System upgrade to Gaynor Telesystems of Redding, CA in the total amount of \$65,085 plus a 10% contingency for a not to exceed amount of \$71,594 with the finding that it is in the best interest of the City.
