Background



- City proposes to widen Bridge Street between Gray Avenue and Cooper Avenue
- Final segment of a multi-phased project to complete the entire Bridge Street corridor from State Route 99 to State Route 70, connecting Yuba City and Marysville
- MHM has prepared the plans, specifications, and estimate


<u> Analysis</u>



- The project includes the following features:
 - 2 lanes in each direction with left-turn pockets at 4-way intersections
 - Raised landscape medians with double mast arm, decorative street light poles
 - Landscape park strips with decorative street light poles at intersections
 - On-street parking with Class 2 bicycle lanes
 - Decorative traffic signals with upgraded controllers
 - ADA-accessible sidewalks and high-visibility crosswalks
 - Concrete block wall on the north side with provisions for future artwork
 - Driveways for future access to development of vacant parcels

Analysis





<u>Analysis</u>



 With Council approval of plans and specifications, and authorization to advertise for bids, staff anticipates the following schedule:

Advertise for Bid: December – January 2022

Award Contract: February – March 2022

Start of Construction: April 2022

Completion: December 2022

- Staff has issued a Request for Proposals for Construction Management and Inspection Services
- Labor compliance services will be administered by a consultant

Fiscal Impact



- Total estimated project cost is estimated at \$7,173,533
 - Includes 10% construction contingency, 10% construction admin/inspection fee, and 1% design services during construction fee
- Project will be funded through CIP Account 1187 (Bridge Street Widening), which currently has about \$5.6 million, including \$2.8 million in Local Partnership Program funding for the project through the California Transportation Commission (CTC)
- Staff will propose funding recommendations to address shortfalls, based on actual bid prices, at time of award

Alternatives



- Do not approve the plans and specifications and delay the project (CTC funding requires award of the project by June 2022)
- Direct staff to modify the plans and specifications

Recommendations



 Adopt a Resolution approving the plans and specifications for the Bridge Street Widening Project (21-01) and authorizing advertisement for bids on the project
