# Background

- SB 1383 Short-lived Climate Pollutant Reduction Act of 2016
- January 1, 2022: City compliance
- January 1, 2024: Local entities compliance & City enforcement
- Compliance and enforcement in coordination with Yuba-Sutter Regional Waste Management Authority (RWMA)



### Code Updates for SB 1383 Compliance

Section	Update	Implementation
7-10.03 (Compliance with CALGreen Building Standards recycling requirements)	Adds the CALGreen recycling requirements that were amended as part of SB 1383.	CALGreen already adopted in 2019 and is the guiding standard for the Building Division.
7-18 (Model Water Efficient Landscape Ordinance)	Adds official adoption of the State's MWELO and the SB 1383 amendments to the MWELO regarding organic materials.	MWELO already included in the City's planning reviews and annual reporting.
6-3 (Mandatory Refuse Collection Services)	Adds new definitions and guidance regarding organic waste; adds inspection and enforcement mechanisms*; and amends chapter to match current standards.	Amendment to Recology contract will implement the organic waste requirements; RWMA will take responsibility for conducting inspection and enforcement measures.
6-4.03 (Placement of garden refuse)	Amendsreferenceto6-3-11(Cuttings), which has been removedfrom the amended Chapter 3.	No change for the City; residents to dispose of organic waste per collection contract.

\*Resolution also included to adopt the enforcement penalty fee schedule.



# SB 1383 Next Steps

- Amendment of City's contract with Recology to include organic waste collection requirements
- Paper procurement ordinance
- Coordinate with RWMA to initiate inspection and outreach for the region
- RWMA & City to implement ordinance updates



## Recommendation

A. Introduce an Ordinance of the City Council of the City of Yuba City adding Section 7-10.03 of Chapter 10 of Title 7, adding Chapter 18 (Model Water Efficient Landscape Ordinance) of Title 7, amending Chapter 3 (Mandatory Refuse Collection Services) of Title 6, and amending Section 6-4.03 of Chapter 4 of Title 6 of the Yuba City Municipal Code to comply with Senate Bill 1383 by title only and waive the first reading

B. Adopt a Resolution amending the User Fee Schedule to include Administrative Civil Penalties to enforce compliance with Senate Bill 1383
