# Wireless Telecommunications Facility Ordinance Background



## Background:

- In Recent years wireless telecommunication facilities have evolved into various types of facilities, the two broad classifications are **administrative** and **major wireless** telecommunication facilities
- **Major wireless** telecommunication facilities are know as “macro-cells”
- **Administrative wireless** telecommunication facilities are know as “small wireless facilities” (SWF)
- The FCC released a Declaratory Ruling and Third Report and Order (FCC Order) defining a SWF and significantly limiting state and local management of SWFs in the public right-of-way.

# Wireless Telecommunications Facility Ordinance Analysis



## Analysis:

- The Wireless Telecommunications Facility Ordinance provides the regulatory framework and standards for permitting the installation of Small Wireless Facilities
- Permitting for wireless telecommunication facilities and SWFs will require a new type of permit, titled a Wireless Telecommunication Facility Permit

# Wireless Telecommunications Facility Ordinance

## Fiscal Impact



### Fiscal Impact:

- No fiscal impact is associated with the ordinance outside of staff time. However, installation of wireless facilities would be subject to fees. A Master License Agreement for use of the City infrastructure in the right-of-way will be needed and a Resolution establishing fees associated with these applications will be presented to Council at the time of the second reading.

# Wireless Telecommunications Facility Ordinance Recommendation



## Recommendation:

- Introduce an Ordinance of the City Council of the City of Yuba City adding Chapter 8 Wireless Telecommunications Facilities in the Public Right of Way to Title 6 of the Yuba City Municipal Code by title only and waive the first reading.
