Summary

Subject: Community Sponsorship Requests

Recommendation: Consider the Sponsorship Requests from the Alliance for Hispanic Advancement

and Yuba Sutter Arts & Culture, and if approved:

A. Adopt a Resolution to approve a monetary Sponsorship request from the Alliance for Hispanic Advancement (AHA) of up to \$6,000.00 to advance Hispanic heritage in our local communities through community action, educational enhancement, and economic development

B. Adopt a Resolution to approve a monetary Sponsorship request from the Yuba Sutter Arts & Culture of up to \$10,000.00 for the support of a Mural Marathon and Utility Box Mini Mural event in Yuba City

Fiscal Impact: Monetary Sponsorships in the amount up to \$16,000.00

Council's Strategic Goal:

The overarching strategic goal of "Quality of Life."

Purpose:

City sponsorships reflect support of specific programs or events by an organization. The intent is that the public will receive some intrinsic cultural, economic, educational, or entertainment value from the program or event.

Background:

On January 18, 2022, Council adopted an Amended Community Sponsorship Policy which specifies the following factors that will be considered during the approval process:

- All monetary sponsorship requests will be approved by the City Council at a public meeting.
- Resources available (e.g., budget, staff, workload capacity, etc.)
- Compatibility with the strategic goals of the City Council and the mission of Yuba City.
- Impact of an event on City Facilities.
- Risk to the City.

- The ability of the organization to obtain liability insurance naming the City as an additional insured.
- The overall benefit to the community.

The following sponsorship requests were received from:

Alliance for Hispanic Advancement

AHA has over 30 years of local committed leadership, providing multiple services to the Yuba City Hispanic heritage community and business owners. AHA shares the same "Quality of Life" priority as the City does. AHA empowers our Hispanic community to foster pride and commitment to contributing back to our City. AHA is a well-respected and recognized non-profit in the Yuba-Sutter region. These funds would help develop and continue the services and programs, including education, community involvement, and business economics.

Yuba Sutter Arts & Culture

Yuba Sutter Arts & Culture exists to expand artistic awareness and engagement in the arts and culture and to encourage our diverse, underserved, local communities to reach their full potential by experiencing arts programs that serve their needs. Yuba Sutter Arts & Culture plays an essential role in our communities to ensure the highest quality and widest variety of arts & culture activities and programs are available, including performing arts, visual arts, literary arts, and public art for all residents of Sutter and Yuba Counties.

Analysis:

The Amended Community Sponsorship Policy states, "The budget for the Community Sponsorship Program shall be established by City Council each year during the annual budget process", and "applications will be presented to Council quarterly on a first-come, first-serve basis." Through the FY 22/23 Budget, Council established the following.

Fiscal Impact:

As noted above, there is \$15,000 budgeted for Community Contributions, which would apply to the AHA request, and \$10,000 budgeted for Community Events, which would apply to the Yuba Sutter Arts & Culture request.

Yuba Sutter Arts & Culture Community Sponsorship Application

Organization Purpose/Mission

Yuba Sutter Arts & Culture exists to expand artistic awareness and engagement in the arts and culture and to encourage our diverse, underserved, local communities to reach full potential by experiencing arts programs that serve their needs. We play an essential role in our communities to ensure the highest quality and widest variety of arts & cultural activities and programs are available including performing arts, visual arts, literary arts and public art for all residents of Sutter and Yuba Counties.

Please explain how your program or event meets one or more of the sponsorship criteria below:

Program Outline

O Yuba Sutter Arts & Culture proposes a two-part public arts project. First, we propose to paint five additional Yuba City owned utility boxes with graphic murals to be chosen by a City appointed committee from submissions received following a public call to artists for renderings. The second part of the request is for matching funds for a Yuba City Mural Marathon. Five artists, again chosen by a committee based on submissions, will have 48 hours (Friday to Sunday) to complete their 20'x24' murals on the Church Street side of the Sutter Theater Center for the Arts. There are five distinct sections to the south facing wall that lend themselves perfectly to this type of event. We will also host an arts festival on the street and adjacent parking lot on Sunday when the artists are wrapping up and during the awards ceremony.

Boosts the local Yuba City economy

O Public art projects on any scale attract a lot of attention. The 30+ utility box murals we completed over the past few years have been the single most popular project we have undertaken. Members of the community have taken it upon themselves to create online

projects like "art crawls" where people were encouraged to take selfies with the utility boxes and then add hashtags to compete for gift cards. Talk about community engagement! It was like our own local version of Pokemon Go.

- o The Mural Marathon is modeled on the annual event at Circus Circus in Reno. In 2018, we conducted the first local Mural Marathon in Live Oak and transformed a derelict supermarket with five magnificent murals. The Yuba City event will be even bigger. We will bring a large crowd to the Plumas Lake business corridor for a very unique experience. Beginning on Friday, we will have a kickoff "meet the artists" event. Then the artists will begin work on their murals. We will have a community art festival over the course of the weekend with a wrap up party and awards ceremony on Sunday afternoon. The event will be highly publicized, and we anticipate visitors from adjoining counties will come to share the experience. This will be our local version of Wide-Open Walls, the wildly successful annual mural marathon in Sacramento that's been running for over ten years.
- Provides an opportunity to help build community, foster a sense of pride within our community, and engage our community
 - Murals both large and small become selfie destinations. We have seen this over and over again with the murals we have created in Marysville and Live Oak. We want to bring this experience to Yuba City and the Plumas Street Corridor which has significantly more foot traffic that either of the other two cities. The wall murals on the side of the theater will provide remarkable photo opportunities for residents and visitors. This is exactly the sort of thing that helps engender a pride of place sentiment.
- Contributes positively to the recognition and image of the City of Yuba City
 - As the premier city in our region, Yuba City can further cement its leadership role by supporting public art projects of this nature.
 Studies show that investments in public art can improve street safety, support tourism and new jobs, and combat social

isolation and anxiety. Public art adds enormous value to the cultural, aesthetic and economic vitality of a community. It is a well-accepted principle of urban design that public art contributes to a community's identity, fosters community pride and a sense of belonging, and enhances the quality of life for its residents and visitors.
