Richland Village Affordable Housing

- Richland Village 470 Bernard Drive
- 176 unit Affordable Housing Development
- Estimated Cost \$73.2M



Project Background

---- December 2020:

Planning Commission voted to recommend City Council approval of the proposed project

---- January 2021:

City Council approves Richland Village Development Plan 20-03

City Council recommends an Ad Hoc Committee is formed regarding Funding Request

---- May 2021:

City Council approves funding request

---- March 2022:

Regional Housing Authority submitted a timely extension of time request for Development Plan 20-03 and the associated City Council funding commitment

Richland Village Budget

- RHA Updated Project Estimate: \$73.2M
 - Approximately \$409K/unit
- The project recently was awarded \$30M in funding through the California Department of Housing and Community Development's, Affordable Housing Sustainable Communities (AHSC) program.
 - \$8.5M is designated for Yuba-Sutter Transit
- Application for tax-credit financing of \$51M

<u>Analysis</u>

- Conditions of approval of the project (DP 22-03) remain valid
- Extension requested due to the timing of applying for additional funding

Recommendation

Approve a two-year extension of time for Development Plan 22-03 and the associated funding commitment, pursuant to City Municipal Code Section 8-5.7106, resulting in a new expiration date of January 19, 2025.
