**Regular Meeting—Council Chambers**

The City of Yuba City Regular Council meeting was called to order by Mayor Didbal at 6:07 pm

**Roll Call**

Councilmember Cardoza led the Pledge of Allegiance

**Presentations and Proclamations**

**1. Richard Dettmer – Personnel Board and Senior Commissioner**

Mayor Didbal presented a proclamation and gift to Richard Dettmer for his more than 17 years of volunteer service to the City. Laura Nicholson presented a joint recognition award from Senator Jim Nielson and Assemblyman James Gallagher.

Adopt **Ordinance No. 001-18** adding Title 7, Chapter 17 to the Municipal Code relating to expedited permitting procedures for electric vehicle charging stations, and waive the second reading

The motion was passed with a unanimous vote

**4. Public Consumption and Possession of Alcoholic Beverages**

Councilmember Buckland moved and Councilmember Cleveland seconded the motion to:  
Adopt **Ordinance No. 002-18** repealing and re-enacting Chapter 6 of Title 5 of the Yuba City Municipal Code regarding Public Consumption and Possession of Alcoholic Beverages, and waive the second reading

The motion passed with a unanimous vote


