LOT LINE ADJUSTMENT FILING INSTRUCTIONS

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Completed Application for Lot Line Adjustment (attached). All property owners involved must sign the application.
Two copies of a map of the proposed adjustment, <u>drawn to scale</u> , showing locations of existing and proposed lot lines and any structures, wells, septic tanks, leach lines, etc. on the properties involved.
Two copies of descriptions of the resultant parcels. The descriptions must be drawn, stamped, and signed by a California State licensed surveyor or engineer. The descriptions must describe each resultant parcel by metes and bounds and contain a statement acknowledging combination or reduction of any affected lots or portions of lots previously created by parcel map or subdivision.
Appropriate fee
After the lot line adjustment has been recorded, a copy of the recorded deeds/parcel map must be submitted to Planning to finalize the process.

NOTES:

Any approval of a lot line adjustment will be subject to the following conditions, plus any other appropriate condition which should be applied.

- No new parcels or building sites shall be created as a result of this lot line adjustment.
- Any Deed(s) of Trust shall be adjusted commensurate with the new property descriptions.
- The adjustment is not final until the descriptions accumulating and reducing the parcels affected are recorded with an acknowledgement that prior parcel lines are eliminated by this action, and a copy of the recorded documents is submitted to the Planning Division in the Community Development Department.
