Subject: City Welcome Sign – Ad Hoc Committee

Recommendation: Designate one member of the Planning Commission to the City's sign Ad

Hoc Committee.

Project Description:

Yuba City has two welcome signs located at the southwest intersection of Township Road / State Route 20 and approximately 1,100 feet southeast of the Bogue Road / Hwy 99 intersection. Due to disrepair, the signs were removed. Based on direction from Council, a two-part design process was implemented.

- 1. Design Concept Competition (Call for Artists)
- 2. Request for Proposals (final design, fabrication, and installation)

Background:

On December 4, 2023, the Call for Artists was distributed in coordination with the Yuba Sutter Arts Council, Yuba Sutter Chamber of Commerce, and Yuba City Unified School District. The Call for Artists outlined the design competition process and submission details (See Attachment 1). On February 2, 2024, the competition was closed. Staff received ten (10) design concept submissions.

On February 20, 2024, the City Council established the City Welcome Sign Ad Hoc committee. Councilmembers Kirchner and Pasquale were designated to steer the committee. The committee will also include a Commissioner from each City Commission – Planning Commission, Senior Commission, Parks & Recreation Commission, and the Youth Commission. The Committee will coordinate with staff to facilitate the meetings, identify necessary staff to participate in each meeting (if needed), and coordinate the preparation of a report with recommendations applicable to the entire City Council.

Recommended Action:

Designate one member of the Planning Commission to the City's sign Ad Hoc Committee.

CALL FOR ARTISTS: CITY OF YUBA CITY "WELCOME" SIGNS

SUBMISSION DEADLINE EXTENDED TO FEBRUARY 1, 2024!

The City of Yuba City ("City") is seeking local artist to design new "Welcome" Signs for the City. The old City Welcome Signs are shown in *Attachment 2*.

PROJECT BACKGROUND

Yuba City has two welcome signs located at the southwest intersection of Township Road / State Route 20 and approximately 1,100 feet southeast of the Bogue Road / Hwy 99 intersection. The existing monument sign masonry style base will likely remain. The design concept being requested in this "Call for Artists" is for a new sign that can be mounted to the existing masonry style base and electrical source. It is possible that the existing masonry style base may not be useable, so feel free to design a concept without the existing base if desired.

The design concept should reflect the City's broad diversity, cultural history, and align with the City brand (*Attachment 3*). Through grant funds awarded by Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG), the winning design concept will be utilized in the design and construction of the new "Welcome" sign(s). The winner will receive \$200.

Please read the instructions for submission guidelines below and submit your proposals by 11:59 pm on January 15, 2024 February 1, 2024.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- Location(s): The existing masonry bases are located southwest of the intersection of Township Road / State Route 20 and approximately 1,100 feet southeast of the Bogue Road / Hwy 99 intersection.
- **Project Intent/Theme:** Must follow theme and branding established by the City of Yuba City. The general themes are as follows:
 - Yuba City's natural beauty including the Feather River, Sutter Buttes, and local wildlife
 - Yuba City's early agricultural settlement, history, and ethnic diversity
- Open to: Competition is open to all.
- Artist Award: The winning artist shall be awarded \$200 and recognition from the City Council.
- Application Process:
 - Complete the "Design Competition Entry Form" (Attachment 1)
 - Submit up to three (3) sign concept submissions (original drawings or digital images are acceptable).
 - Submissions may be mailed or dropped off at the City Hall at 1201 Civic Center Blvd.,
 Yuba City, CA 95991, attention Ashley Potočnik, or emailed to

 subject "Yuba City Welcome Sign."
- Additional Design Requirements: Provide a design of the monument sign which meets or exceeds the following City sign requirements:



- Multi faced sign incorporating something along the lines of "Welcome to Yuba City" and "Thank you for visiting" on either side.
- Architectural elements such as columns, pilasters, cornices, trellises, and similar details shall provide design interest and frame the sign.
- Signs shall be constructed of materials and colors consistent with the City brand. The State Route (SR) 20 Master Plan includes several design concepts for City brand and signage along Hwy 99 and SR 20. This document can be used as needed (*Attachment* 4).
- Monument signs shall have an encasing constructed of brick, stone, synthetic material, or masonry. An aluminum and/or sheet metal encasing is not an acceptable material.
- Embellishment, either structural or decorative elements of a sign incorporating representations of the significant architectural features of the associated building or development may be included.
- Integration/Original Artwork: Artists submitting artwork for consideration will assure the following:
 - o The artwork is solely the result of the artistic effort of the artist.
 - An original artwork design that considers the site, its purpose, and visitors. The design will be community focused, with a unique eye on creating a community sense of self through art.
 - Artwork must have qualities considered to be pleasant, uplifting, and inspirational; reflective of the themes established by the City of Yuba City and illustrated with visual interest, inventiveness, and uniqueness.
- Selection Process: The judging and selection of submissions will be conducted by the City of Yuba City, with final selection by City Council. All decisions will be final. The selected artist(s) will be notified by telephone or e-mail. Public announcement of the selections will be posted by the City of Yuba City on social media and a presentation will be made to City Council.
- Submission Deadline EXTENDED: 11:59 pm on January 15, 2024 February 1, 2024
- Selection Announcement: February 20, 2024 March 5, 2024
