The City is seeking public comment on the following document and will hold a public hearing for the following:

2021-2022 Annual Action Plan: The City of Yuba City is an entitlement jurisdiction receiving a federal formula grant from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Renewal (HUD). The intent of the grant funds is to provide decent housing, a suitable living environment and to expand economic opportunities primarily for low and moderate-income persons. On an annual basis, the City must prepare an Action Plan that outlines planned activities for the upcoming fiscal year. More specifically, the Action Plan includes the proposed budget for CDBG funds, the Federal Application for Assistance, and a discussion of actions the City will undertake during the program year regarding homelessness and anti-poverty initiatives.
