SENIOR MEALS

1. Yuba-Sutter Meals on Wheels- (916) 486-1876 or 1 (800) 211-4545

- *Receive meals delivered to your home.*

Qualifications- For seniors 60+, homebound due to illness, recovery or disability. Paperwork required.

2. Dine Around Town Program- (916) 486-1876 or 1 (800) 211-4545

- *Receive free vouchers for healthy meals at participating restaurants in the area.*

Qualifications-For seniors 60+. Paperwork required.

3. Yuba-Sutter Food Bank- (530) 673-3834 Address: 760 Stafford Way, Yuba City

- *Pick up fresh produce and other food items at the distribution site according to your zipcode. Refer to distribution list (copies located on Senior Center front counter).*

Qualifications- Distribution sites are by zipcode. All programs require zipcode specific proof of residency and photo ID. Some programs require pre-qualification. Call the Food Bank for more information.
