☐ List of subcontractors – including traffic control, CCTV, and restoration subcontractors (must have insurance on file and a City business license)	
Emergency Encroachment Permits	
☐ Contact inspector ASAP via phone, voicemail, or email – before or during work (including weekend hours)	
☐ Submit application packet within 30 days after emergency work is completed (same as non-emergency process above)
