Subject:	CalRecycle Rubberized Pavement Grant FY 17-18
Recommendation:	Adopt a Resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute and submit all necessary grant documentation for the CalRecycle Grants in the amount of \$75,000.
Fiscal Impact:	Minimal staff costs associated with the preparation and administration of the Grant

#### Purpose:

To secure road funding through the CalRecycle Rubberized Pavement Grant Program.

#### **Background**:

The California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) has issued a call for applications for their Rubberized Pavement Grant Program Fiscal Year 17-18. The grant program provides up to \$1.00 per square yard of reimbursement to the City for constructing Asphalt Rubber Chip Seals that use the required amount of recycled tires.

As part of the grant program, the application requires an authorizing resolution from the local agency authorizing the submittal of the grant application and empowering a designated individual to execute the necessary grant documents.

#### <u>Analysis</u>:

The Public Works Department is in the process of developing the 2018 Residential Resurfacing Project. The project will include approximately 75,000 square yards of Asphalt Rubber Chip Seal. Public Works desires to apply for the Rubberized Pavement Grant Program through CalRecycle to offset construction costs.

The City has utilized the CalRecycle grant in the past with good results.

## Fiscal Impact:

Minimal staff costs will be associated with the application and administration of the grant should the City obtain grant funding. The City is anticipating approximately \$75,000 in grant funding.

## Alternatives:

Delay or modify recommended action.

#### Recommendation:

Adopt a resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute and submit all necessary grant documentation for the available CalRecycle grants. (Grant Application: \$75,000)

## RESOLUTION NO.

## RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YUBA CITY AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL OF APPLICATIONS FOR ALL CALRECYCLE GRANTS FOR WHICH THE CITY OF YUBA CITY IS ELIGIBLE.

WHEREAS, Public Resources Code sections 40000 et seq. authorize the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to administer various grant programs in furtherance of the State of California's (State) efforts to reduce, recycle, and reuse solid waste generated in the State thereby preserving landfill capacity and protecting public health and safety and the environment; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of this authority CalRecycle is required to establish procedures governing the application, awarding, and management of the grants; and

WHEREAS, CalRecycle grant application procedures require, among other things, an Applicant's governing body to declare by resolution certain authorizations related to the administration of CalRecycle grants.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the City Council of the City of Yuba City authorizes the submittal of applications to CalRecycle for all grants for which the City of Yuba City is eligible.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the City Manager, or his/her designee is hereby authorized and empowered to execute in the name of the City of Yuba City all grant documents, including but not limited to, applications, agreements, amendments, and requests for payment, necessary to secure grant funds and implement the approved grant project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these authorizations are effective for five (5) years from the date of adoption of the resolution.

The foregoing resolution was duly and regularly introduced, passed, and adopted by the City Council of the City of Yuba City at a regular meeting thereof held on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of October 2017.
