Fiscal Impact:	Will increase annual revenue of \$500 to \$1,000 per year

Purpose:

Help Sutter Animal Services Authority (SASA) offset the costs of housing, feeding, or euthanizing animals.

Background:

Currently, SASA has no fee for the surrender, euthanasia, or adoption of other animals including wildlife, that are not dogs, cats or livestock. This has always been a source of confusion. This classification of pets includes rodents, rabbits, birds and reptiles.

Analysis:

Staff is requesting the Board consider creating a fee structure for surrender, euthanasia and adoption for this classification of animals (Exhibit A). Fees would help offset the cost of specialty foods, cages, and euthanasia. In 2015, SASA took in 150 animals and adopted out 34. In 2016, SASA took in 147 animals and adopted out 30.

If approved new fees would be implemented 30 days from approval.

Alternatives:

- 1. Deny the recommendation and continue the past practice of not charging for this classification of animal.
- 2. Request staff return with more information from other jurisdictions.

Recommendation:

Adopt surrender, euthanasia, and adoption fees for Rodents, Reptiles, Birds and Rabbits.
