Crane Service Truck Uses...

- * Used daily primarily by the Water Distribution division for:
 - * Lifting tapping machines and new valves
 - * Removing and placing steel traffic plates, fire hydrants and check valves
 - * Will carry a large compressor to run air (pneumatic) tools
 - * May be used by other divisions to replace street light poles, lift station pump maintenance, and placing concrete benches and signs

While it appears Cobalt was the low bidder, the bid did not include the required sales tax, which would add another \$11,000 to the cost of the truck.

Recommendation...

*Staff's recommendation is to award the purchase of one crane service truck to Lodi Truck and Equipment of West Sacramento, CA in the amount of \$144,963.75 by finding it is in the best interest of the city to do so.

Heavy Duty...

- * Why 16+ ton weight rating?
 - * The chassis is rated for 33,000 lbs., gross weight
 - * This is the maximum for everything bolted to the chassis (including the engine), plus the load (including whatever the crane is lifting, up to 2,000 lbs. of payload, a half-ton compressor, fuel and fluids, the driver, tools, etc.)
 - * Crane can lift approximately 3 tons

Trade or Auction?

- * The current truck is a 2008 Ford 550.
- * Staff estimates the residual value at auction to be \$12,000-\$15,000.
- * Lodi Truck and Equipment indicated that they are not interested in taking the truck as a trade-in.
