### National Night Out - Tuesday August 6th

### **News Article Highlight**



Hello Members and friends of Yuba-Sutter, attached is a re-publish of a GREAT column that ran in the Appeal Democrat a few months ago. I was able to contact the author and reprint it here with his permission. It was written by Maury Robertson who writes the weekly Perceptions Column.

### The Best Thing about Yuba-Sutter

When we moved here over twenty years ago, my wife and I were struck by how the natives consistently told us that the greatest virtue of Yuba-Sutter was that it was so close to other things. Pick your pleasure: shopping, fishing, big city life, camping, dining—anything you wanted was only an hour away.

In the movie, O Brother Where Art Thou, Everett (George Clooney) is broken down in some backwater town. He needs a part for his car and some Dapper Dan (his favorite hair cream). In a slow drawl, an infuriatingly patient shopkeeper explains that everything will take two weeks to arrive.

Everett finally explodes. "Well ain't this place a geographical oddity: two weeks from everywhere!" That's how people think of Yuba-Sutter. A geographical oddity. An hour from anywhere.

It is true that Yuba-Sutter offers attractions in all directions: North to Chico for some college atmosphere. West for a day in the big city or time at the ocean. South for a play or a meal in Midtown. East to the Sierras for camping.

But the natives left something out. I notice the omission when I bike around the Buttes, or hear the honkers fly overhead, or when my eyes pop at pink prune blossoms in a sea of yellow mustard. It hits me when a great horned owl flies low beside my car at night, or I pull a striper from the Feather River, or a crop duster gracefully seeds a field.

I think about it when I get stuck behind a tractor and thank God I'm not in Bay Area traffic, or when I stick something in the ground and practically watch it grow before my eyes, or when I go to a high school football game, or walk through an uncrowded store and bump into old friends.

I have started to suspect that the natives always talk about all the great things being an hour away because they don't want to let the secret out:

The best thing about Yuba-Sutter is right under our feet.
