



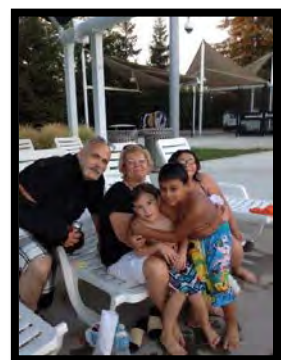
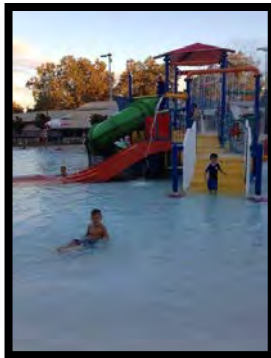

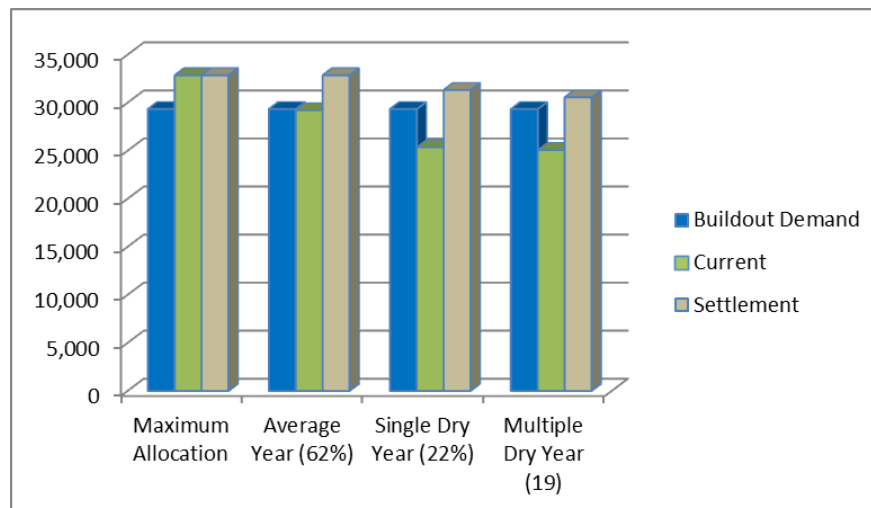
Employee Family Swim Night at the GAP

Kids dived for dollars, jumped off the diving board and played volley ball – *a great time was had by all!* Congratulations to Ben Moody and Darin Gale – their families won the raffles prizes of a family pass to the GAP or a pass to the Bowling Alley.



City Council Meeting Re-Cap – October 1, 2013

- Recognized that October is Domestic Violence Awareness Month to support the efforts of violence prevention
- Awarded the 2013 Striping and Pavement Marking Improvements Project - \$115,400
- Accepted three Public Safety Grants:
 - ★ Sobriety Checkpoint (DUI) - \$19,500
 - ★ Selective Traffic Enforcement - \$47,000. Activities that the grant will fund include:
 - Specialized DUI and drugged driving training
 - DUI Saturation Patrols
 - Motorcycle safety enforcement
 - Distracted driving enforcement
 - Seat belt and child safety seat enforcement
 - Speed, red light and stop sign enforcement
 - Warrant service operations targeting multiple DUI offenders
 - ★ Families Travel Safe Program - \$162,110. Activities that the grant will fund include:
 - Bicycle Rodeo to teach youth to operate their bicycles safely on the streets
 - Child Seat Check-up, where certified child seat technicians help teach care givers to properly install their child seat(s)
 - Classes to train and certify additional child safety technicians
 - Child Safety Seat Violators class where first time child safety seat violators may attend a course to remove the point from their record
 - Distribute more than 200 child safety seats primarily through the child safety seat check-up events
 - Distribute at least 1,000 bicycle helmets though the Bicycle Rodeo's at our schools and at events in our community
- Executed a Settlement Agreement for our Water Contracts with the Department of Water Resources. The City obtains water for its water system through four different permits/contracts from the Feather River. The agreement provides for quantities sufficient to meet build-out demand of 29,324 Acre Feet annually.
