## RECOGNITION OF YUBA CITY 4TH OF JULY CHILDREN'S PARADE & PICNIC COMMUNITY PARTNERS

**WHEREAS**, the Yuba City Fire Department and the Yuba City Parks & Recreation Department created the concept of a Children's Parade and Community Picnic to take place on Independence Day July 4<sup>th</sup> of each year, as a way for our community to commemorate the independence of our country, our community's patriotism and town spirit: and

**WHEREAS**, since the first Yuba City 4<sup>th</sup> of July Children's Parade and Community Picnic in 2002, with hundreds of children on their bikes and accompanied by their families, the parade has grown with the addition of live patriotic music from the **Yuba-Sutter Symphony** and thousands of children and their families participating; and

**WHEREAS**, the Yuba City 4<sup>th</sup> of July Children's Parade and Community Picnic has grown in size and scope, a number of community organizations and businesses have partnered with the City to make the event more enjoyable through their community participation and donation. **Pam Allison of Cleanrite/Buildrite** coordinated the participation and donations of several community organizations for the parade. Those community organizations and businesses have included - **The Cookie Tree** donated 850 cookies to our post-parade picnic; **Sutter Orchard Supply** donated hay bales used on the parade floats; **Sam's Club** donated a gift card used to purchase additional cookies from their bakery; **Recology** donated and delivered all trash bins disposed of the garbage at the conclusion of the event; and Yuba City's **Lowe's** employees who collectively purchased and donated all of the bottles of water for our post-parade picnic; and

**WHEREAS**, the participation and commitment of the individuals and businesses mentioned above have contributed to making the Yuba City 4<sup>th</sup> of July Children's Parade and Community Picnic a positive family-oriented, community-building event for our City, fun for the community's children, and an asset to our community profile.
